EXPRESS YOURSELF

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LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

Request your Letter of Recommendation using the Recommender tab on the left side of your application.

EXPRESS YOURSELF

This is one of the parts of the application where we get the most questions, but we also hope it's the most fun.

If your piece is in a standard file format like .doc, .pdf or .ppt you can upload it directly in the space provided. If it is a link to YouTube, Vimeo or similar, please place the link in a document file, make sure the privacy settings are public and upload the document.

(Videos longer than 3 minutes will be disqualified.)

Please be sure to name your document with your first name, last name and the words personal expression. (Ex: *Jane Doe Personal Expression*)

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

You should request your letter of recommendation ASAP. From past years we know that it often takes recommenders 3-4 weeks to be able to write the letter and get it submitted.
